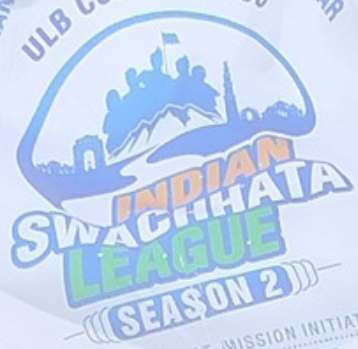

SBM-U 2.0 THROWBACK 2023

The sanitation landscape in urban India is undergoing a significant transformation. The second phase of Swachh Bharat Mission is focusing on eliminating garbage from cities, aiming to create garbage-free urban areas. In 2023, swachhata took centrestage as jan andolan for clean urban India saw a new peak. From PM-led Shramdaan for Swachhata to women-led Swachhotsav, from youth-led ISL to citizen-led RRR Centres, campaign for clean toilets we witnessed it all. Many projects were approved under Waste to Wealth and SafaiMitra Suraksha was prioritized by cities. Swachh Bharat Mission fostered collaborations and knowledge sharing and incubated startups in sanitation and waste management. As we look back, here's a wrap up of the year gone by.

Mission Progress: Sanitation

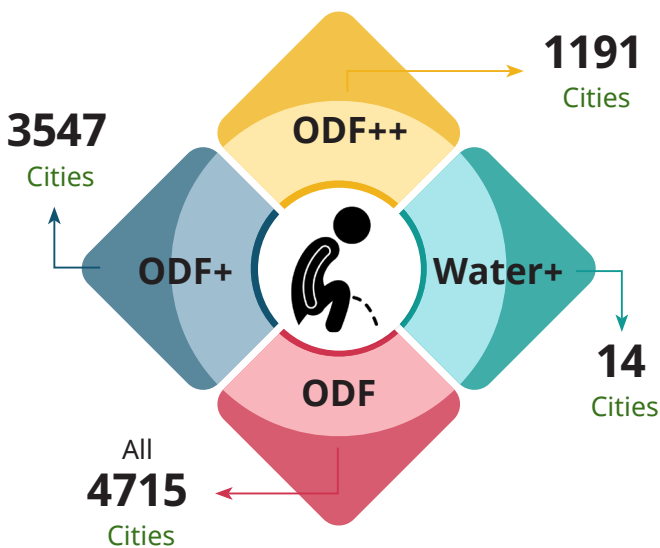
Used Water Management

The Mission is moving towards improving the overall Used Water Management ecosystem in urban India. In the past 1 year cities have been ensuring that no untreated used water is discharged into water bodies, which resonates with the larger objective of the Mission of bringing about a circular economy approach in all its initiatives. MoHUA has also put in place a robust system to expedite STP-FSTP plants. I&D networks, procuring desludging equipments & putting up septic tanks.



Out of the total project cost of Rs. 19980 cr, a substantial amount of Rs. 9310 cr has been approved for release to States as Central Share Allocation for used water management projects. Out of 32, 22 States/UTs have been appraised. The ministry has approved plans for 2522 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs), for STPs with capacity of 7729 MLD and a I&D network of 10987 kms till date.

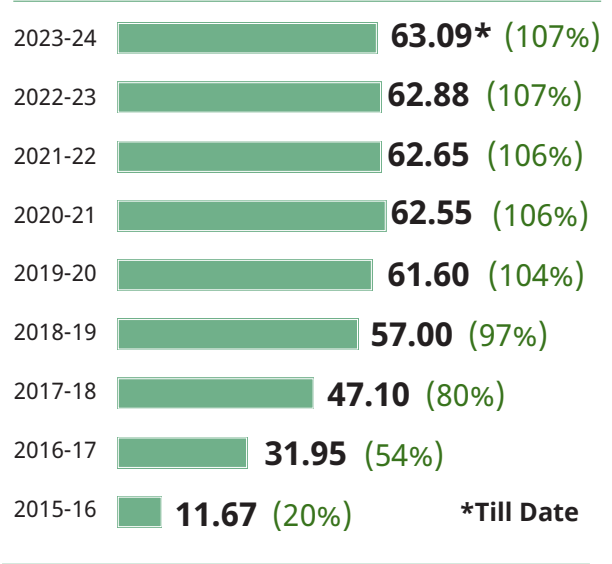
Toilets

In the ongoing phase of the Mission, the focus is on ensuring functionality and maintenance of community, public and aspirational toilets across urban India, the emphasis is on holistic used water management. The construction of IHHLs has exceeded the target by a significant margin.

Out of the total project cost of Rs. 3046 cr., a total of Rs. 904 cr of Central Share Allocation has been approved for the construction of public, community, individual household toilets, and aspirational toilets. Out of 35, projects have been appraised for 25 States/UTs till date.

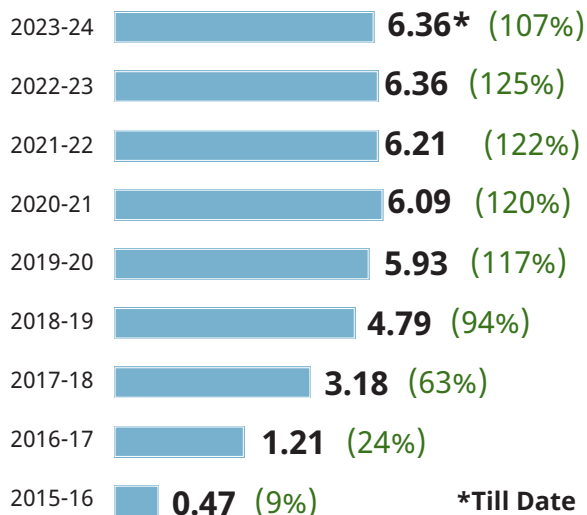
Completed Individual Household Latrines (IHHL)

(In lakhs)



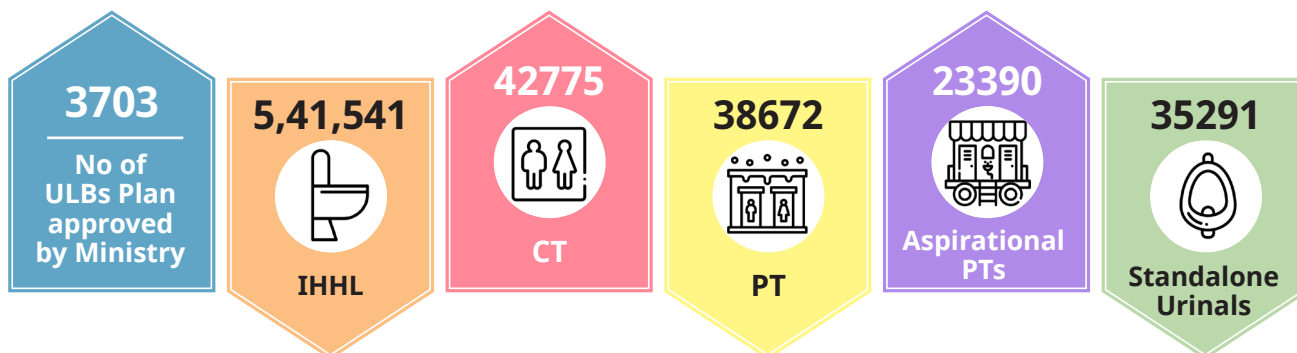
Completed Community & Public Toilets (CT/PTs)

With focus on accelerating sanitation, mechanised desludging and Used Water Management in Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities, SBM-U 2.0 has highlighted the need for innovation, governance, adoption of a circular economy approach by small towns in design and execution to ensure effective management.

Budget 2023 focus

All cities and towns will be enabled for 100 per cent mechanical desludging of septic tanks and sewers to transition from manhole to machine hole mode.

Progress so far

In 2023, 1645 desludging vehicles across 12 States have been sanctioned under SBM-U (10th NARC data) amounting to INR 232 crores.

WAY FORWARD

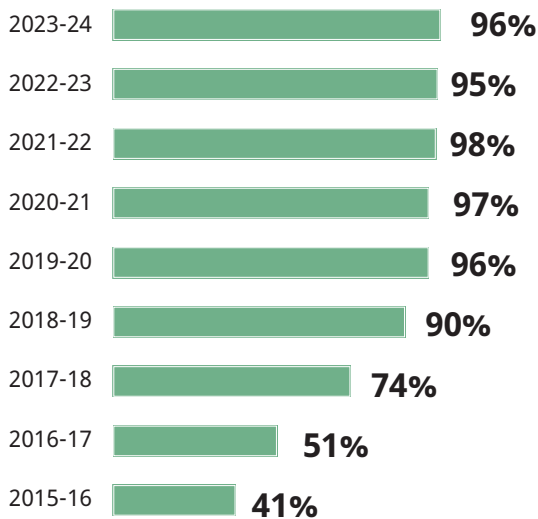
A digital platform to aggregate desludging service operations across urban and rural areas is being planned for citizens to have an easy and safe access to desludging services.

SBM sub-portal under the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal is being revisited to improve the inventory of equipment made available that cater to especially smaller ULBs (population less than 5 lakhs).

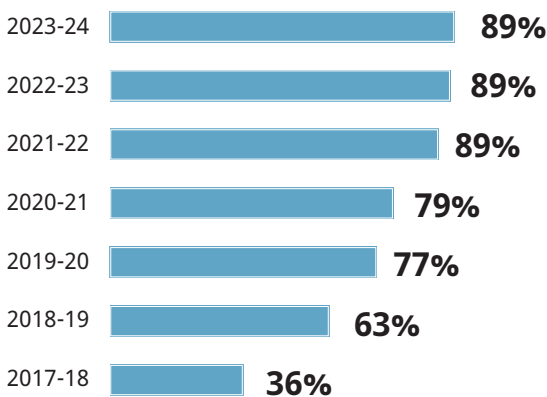
Mission Progress: Solid Waste Management

Under SBM-U 2.0, nearly 97% of urban areas are practicing door-to-door collection of waste, 89% of the waste collected is segregated by source and 77% of the waste is processed.

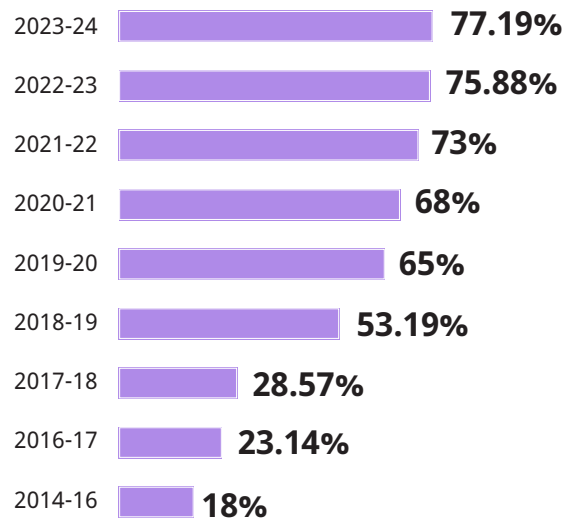
Door-to-door collection (Wardwise)

ADB'S USD 200 MILLION BOOST FOR SWACHH BHARAT

The Asian Development Bank has approved a USD 200 million loan to support the Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban 2.0. This initiative is committed to making all cities garbage-free by 2026. It aims to introduce international best practices, integrate new technologies, and adopt climate and disaster-resilient approaches in municipal solid waste management. This initiative seeks to engage the private sector, strengthen women's participation in sanitation and service delivery. It seeks to enhance comprehensive waste management facilities in 100 cities across eight states.



CITIIS 2.0 LAUNCHED

The City Investments to Innovate, Integrate and Sustain 2.0 (CITIIS 2.0) has been launched this year to provide technical & financial assistance of 135 cr through challenge mode to ULBs in integrated solid waste management. Funded by the French Development Agency (AFD), Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau (KfW), the European Union (EU), and National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA). The period is for 4 years.



Wet Waste Processing

Waste to Compost

Currently there are nearly 2,500 functional Waste to Compost Plants (centralized) with capacity to process 1,13,873 tons of waste per day (TPD). This year, out of Rs 3590 cr project cost, an amount of Rs. 1333 cr of Central Share Allocation has been approved for wet waste/composting plants of 31248 TPD in over 2700 ULBs.



Bio-Methanation

In 2023, out of total project cost of Rs 1495 cr, a total amount of Rs. 458 cr has been allocated as central share of funds for 8532 TPD Bio-methanation plants in 306 ULBs.

BUDGET FOCUS

Focusing on reduction in greenhouse gas emissions and with an aim to highlight the use of green energy, 500 new Waste to Wealth plants under the GOBARdhan scheme was announced for promoting circular economy in Budget 2023. This included 200 compressed biogas plants, 75 in urban areas, 300 community or cluster-based plants, at a total investment of Rs 10,000 Cr.



MoHUA-EIL MoU

MoHUA signed a MoU with Engineers India Limited in February 2023, to provide transaction advisory support and develop Waste to Energy and bio-methanation projects in cities with a population of million plus. Currently over 50 CBG plants have been approved for effective resource recovery from organic waste under the GOBARdhan scheme. It is proposed to attain 15,000 TPD treatment capacity for bio-methanation plants by 2026.

Dry Waste Processing

Material Recovery Facilities

For establishment of Material Recovery Facilities of 45,000 TPD by 2026, the action plans for setting up of 34,494 TPD design capacity in 2,604 ULBs have been approved under SBM (U) 2.0. For a project cost of Rs 2968 cr for 34949 TPD Material Recovery Facilities in over 2600 ULBs, an amount of Rs. 1043 cr Central Share of funds has been allocated.



Waste to Electricity

RDF plants with design capacity of 931 TPD and Waste to Electricity plants for a total processing capacity of 1960 TPD have been approved. In 2023, out of Rs. 353 cr project cost for Waste to Electricity plants, Rs. 69 cr Central share has been allocated for 2 ULBs.

Construction and Demolition & Mechanical Sweeping

The action plans to establish 86 plants with a design capacity of 8,800 TPD, in addition to the existing capacity of 12,307 TPD, for setting up 10,000 TPD C&D waste processing facilities by 2026 in 154 Cities identified under the National Clean Air Program (NCAP) and the remaining 5 lakh population ULBs, has been approved under SBM-U 2.0.

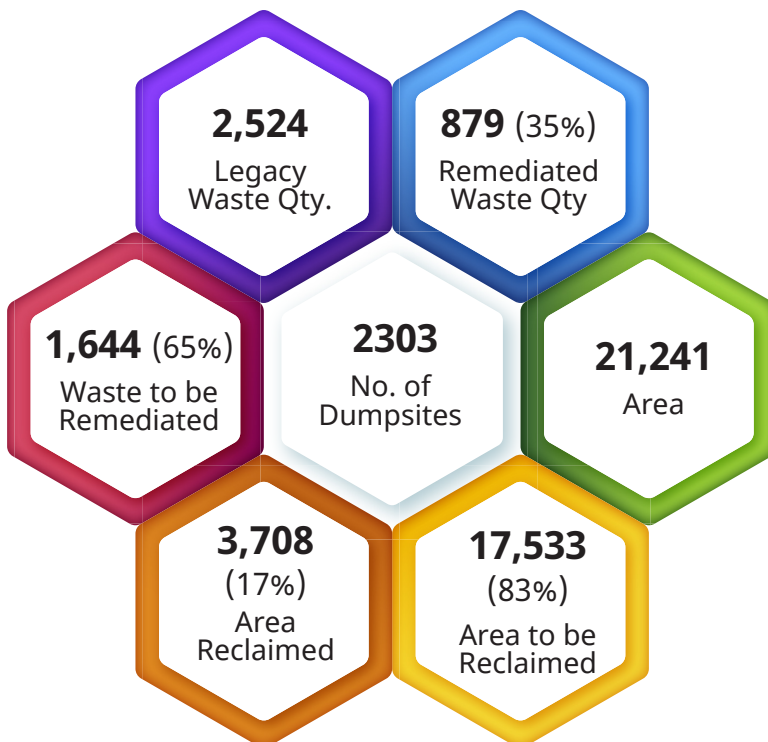


Legacy Dumpsite Remediation

Swachh Bharat Mission- Urban 2.0 is moving towards the goal of 'Lakshya Zero Dumpsite'. This year, an amount of Rs 3571 cr central share of funds has been allocated out of the total project cost of Rs. 8914 cr for legacy waste dumpsite remediation of 1676 lakh MT for over 1700 ULBs.

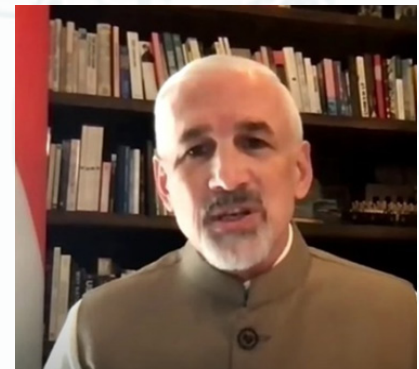

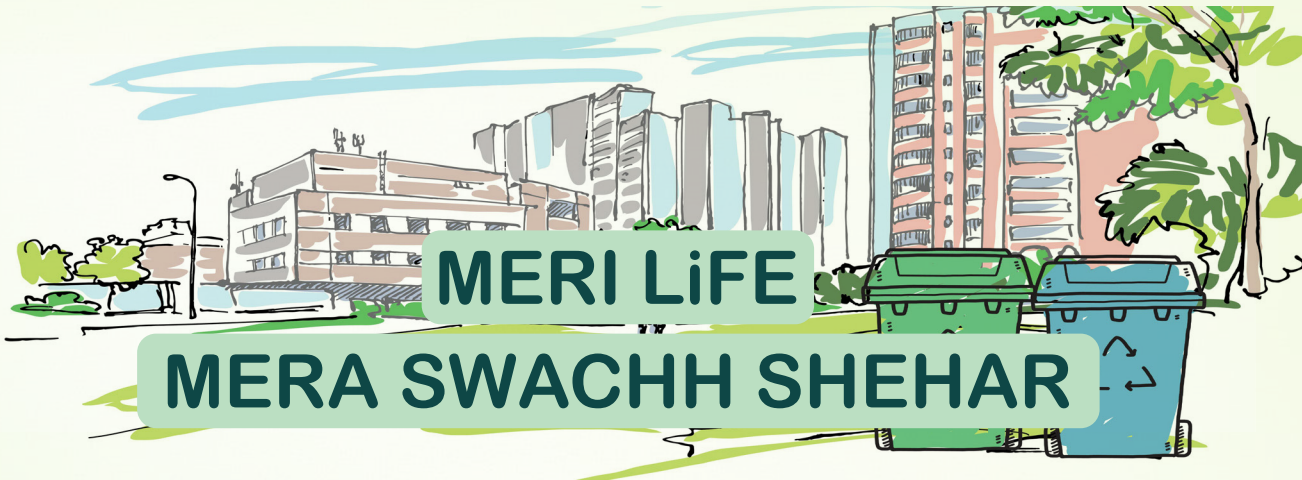

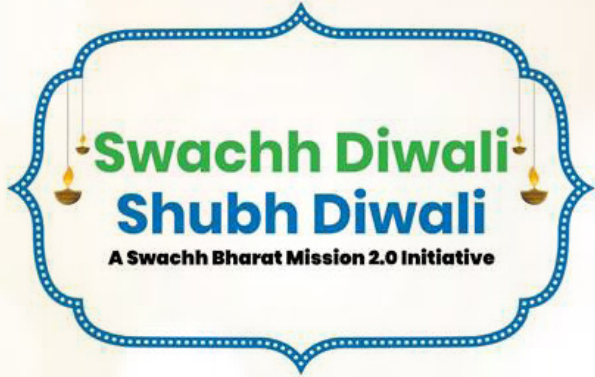

Chandigarh scales up waste processing

This year, the Municipal Corporation scaled up its composting capacity, to ensure effective management of 100% generation of wet waste. Construction started for a 300 TPD windrow compost plant at Dadumajra.

Municipal Corporation launched city's first decentralised waste processing plant at Sehaj Safai Kendra, Sector 49 with the objective of making the ward self-reliant in processing of solid waste generated at the ward level.

An effluent treatment plant was established at the C&D waste recycling plant to treat and reuse the wastewater generated during plant operations.

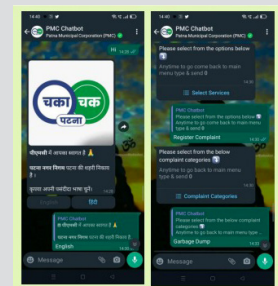

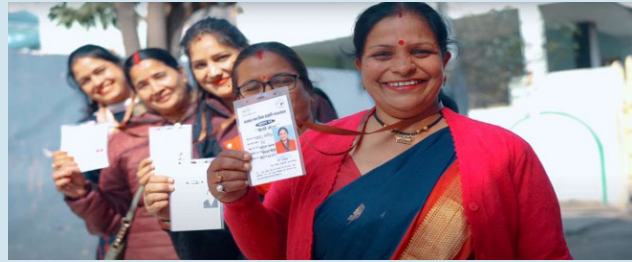

Baini Sena takes charge of sanitation in hill town Haldwani

Over 500 women from nearly 50 Self Help Groups formed the Baini Sena to co-opt for ensuring cleanliness in Haldwani. The Bainis assist in enhancement of work quality of sanitation workers, alert the garbage collection vehicles about garbage dumps, collect user charges to ensure the gateway to the Kumaon hills remains clean.

Andhra Pradesh's e-auto Tippers & desludging vehicles

Under the Clean Andhra Pradesh (CLAP) program, to reduce the stress on sanitation workers, door-to-door waste collection has been mechanized by upgrading the Push Cart Systems to E-Auto Tippers statewide, with the launch of 616 e-autos under this program.

To promote the safety, well-being, and economic advancement of Safai Karamcharis, the State has initiated the Livelihood Development Program under the Swachh Udyami Yojana Scheme by NSKFD in which, 100 vacuum suction desludging vehicles have been launched to ensure the secure and authorized operation of desludging activities.



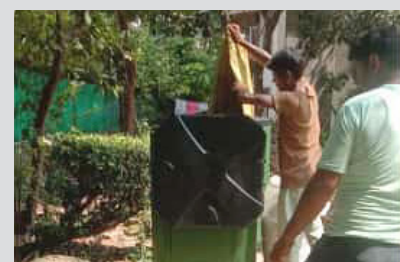

Zero Waste Colonies of Delhi

MCD has come up with the decentralized approach of Zero Waste Colonies. Currently, there are 334 zero waste colonies and all these colonies are self-sufficient in managing their own waste. They generate approx. 69-ton wet waste and 104-ton dry waste. Wet waste is being processed within the community by using different technologies such as pit composting, drum composting, aerobins etc.

UP transforms 75000 public toilets

Kayakalp campaign, an initiative by UP aimed at transforming public toilets and improving cleanliness and hygiene in the toilets across the State, and sustainability of ODF+ status, resulting in 75000 toilet seats transformation with beautiful, clean and hygienic toilets and awareness on hygiene and sanitation of public toilets.

During the Swachh Ghat Pratiyogita in Uttar Pradesh, 136 ghats were identified from 23 districts were identified for cleanliness drive, including the Ganga Towns. Over 2 lakh kgs of waste was collected from these ghats. More than 2 lakh citizens were mobilized during this challenge.

Tamil Nadu revives water bodies

Under the Clean City Campaign, Urban Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu carried out a large-scale campaign of cleaning water bodies and rain water affected drains. 70,000 volunteers were identified for this massive campaign. 3,500 water bodies were cleaned. During this campaign, desilting work was done from water bodies and drains spread over a distance of about 70,000 kilometers.

The Ghost Net Collection Center (GNCC) in Andaman and Nicobar is a waste collection centre, a place where the fishing community deposits their fishing gear fragments for recycling. The center is being run in collaboration with Port Blair Municipal Council, Fisheries Department, GIZ and people from the fishermen community.

Wash Facility for Sanitation Workers in Ladakh

Ladakh Ecological Development Group collaborated with the Leh Municipal Committee and Bremen Overseas Research and Development Association to create a unique 'Wash facility' for sanitation workers in Leh. The facility has been carefully designed to cater to the specific needs of sanitation workers. The 'Wash facility' for sanitation workers has improved toilet and bathing facility for both men and women, provision for black and grey water treatment and reuse of treated water along with various additional features.

Organic Fertilizer from Sikar, Rajasthan

Sikar in Rajasthan is providing organic fertilizers by processing wet waste collected from the city. Around 8-9 tonnes of wet waste is collected from the city every day, out of which 2-3 tonnes of organic compost is created. The farmers are getting the compost for Rs 2 per kg.

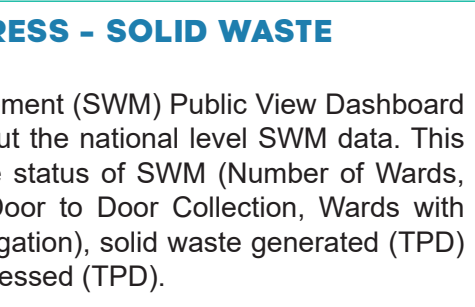

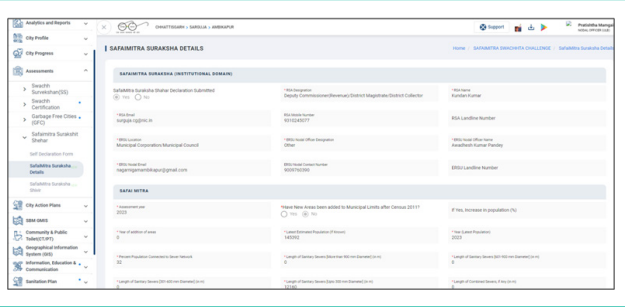
