# Swachh Survekshan Awards 2023



The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs hosted the Swachh Survekshan Awards 2023 on January 11, 2024 in Delhi's Bharat Mandapam, where the Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, felicitated top clean cities of urban India. 24 National, 20 Zonal and 54 State level awards were announced at the event. This year the cleanest city award showcased joint winners. Port city Surat bagged the top honours, alongside Indore, who had conquered the top spot alone for 6 consecutive years. In the category of cities with a population of less

than 1 lakh, Sasvad, Patan and Lonavala secured the top three spots. Mhow Cantonment Board in Madhya Pradesh was adjudged the Cleanest Cantonment Board. Varanasi and Prayagraj won the top two awards amongst the Cleanest Ganga Towns. Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh won the top three awards for Best Performing State. Chandigarh walked away with the award for the Best SafaiMitra Surakshit Sheher. Starting with a modest evaluation of 73 major cities in 2016 and extending its outreach to 4477 cities in the current edition, the magnitude of Swachh Survekshan has increased exponentially. The most awaited award ceremony of the year was convened in the presence of over 3000 guests. The vision of a Garbage Free India under SBM-U 2.0 was given further impetus by announcing the results of 7-star and 5-star rated cities under the Star Rating Protocol of Garbage Free Cities. The revised Star Rating Protocol of Garbage Free Cities was launched in 2021 to holistically evaluate cities across solid waste management parameters. The 9 years of Swachh Bharat Mission and the spirit of swachhata was reinvigorated in the presence of the Hon'ble President, through an audio visual presentation highlighting Ek Tareekh Ek Ghanta Ek Saath campaign and the release of the Swachh Bharat Mission Anthem for 2024. Playback singer, Kailash Kher has lent his voice to the anthem 'Naya Sankalp Hai, Naya Prakash Hai'. Padmashri Sudarsan Pattnaik and his team enthralled the audience with a live sand art creation capturing the journey, milestones and the spirit of Swachh Bharat.

## SS Awards Ceremony 2023

**H**on'ble Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri and Secretary, MoHUA, Shri Manoj Joshi conferred the Swachh Survekshan National, State level and Zonal awards for medium and small clean cities at the ceremony. This year, the clean city awards prioritize addressing legacy dumpsites, managing plastic waste, implementing the principles of Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and ensuring the safety of SafaiMitras. SS 2023 focused on transforming waste into valuable resources and was evaluated by a team of over 3,000 assessors. The survey's emphasis on citizen engagement and feedback has been instrumental in its success. Overall

the survey covered a population of around 409 million. A staggering 12 crore citizen responses were received during the assessment this year, marking an unprecedented level of engagement through various channels. Swachh Survekshan has sparked a sense of healthy competition among cities, motivating them to enhance urban sanitation and provide better services to their residents. The focus

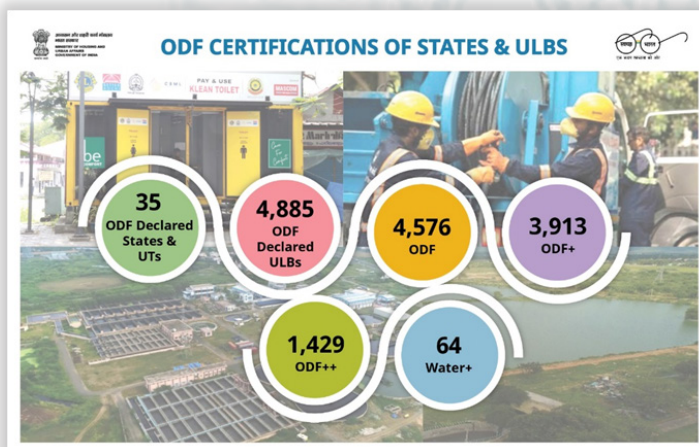

## GFC Star Rating & ODF Certification 2023



Journey towards Garbage Free Cities has been steadily moving upwards and onwards. This year Surat and Navi Mumbai joined the league of 7 Star cities along with Indore. The one-time certified cities have jumped from 445 in 2022 to 673 in 2023. Raipur, Rajkot, Pimpri Chinchwad, Pune, Guntur and Greater Hyderabad are the new 5 Star Cities certified in GFC 2023.

The ODF certifications have seen a sharp rise, especially for ODF++ & Water+, reflecting the tireless and consistent contributions of the States, ULBs and the citizens. Over 4,800 ULBs have been declared ODF and nearly 4,000 are certified ODF+





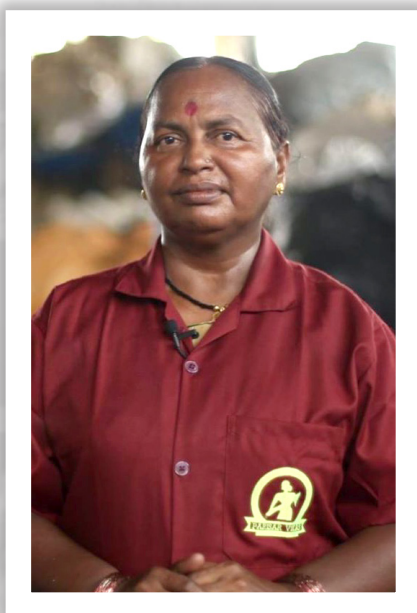
## Women Leaders in Sanitation

### Green Crusader: Dr. Shanthi's Waste Management Mission

**D**r. Shanthi Tummala, a dentist turned environmentalist, is a key member of the Solid Waste Management Round Table (SWMRT) and an expert in home composting. Motivated by the challenges faced by waste collectors, she spearheads efforts to promote source segregation and behavioral change. Through door-to-door engagements and community mobilization, she raises awareness about waste segregation and collaborates with Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) Marshals to enforce penalties on non-compliant areas. She has been educating women to adopt sustainable menstruation practices by using cloth pads or menstrual cups. Additionally, she has also been promoting reusable cutlery and avoiding single-use disposables in shops. As part of the project team, Dr. Shanthi has successfully created awareness among 106000 households leading to the maintenance of a 90% segregation level in the wards.



### Mumbai's Waste Picker-turned-Eco Warrior



**S**ushila Sable has been working as a waste picker for over 47 years now, keeping the city of Mumbai clean with her efforts. In 1998, she came in contact with Shree Mukti Sanghatana, an alliance of Indian Waste-pickers and learnt about why waste segregation is important. Sushila Sable started an SHG of women waste pickers and soon saved enough money to start a dry waste collection centre. That was when her journey as an environmentalist began. She was the first to suggest the creation of SHGs as a means of empowering themselves and within a short span of only 10 months, her area had 10 SHGs. She was also the lone former waste picker to represent India at the Rio+20 United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development held in Brazil. Spearheading a 'zero waste movement,' she trains 3,000 women in waste segregation and recycling, while also supporting community welfare programs.



## Women Leaders in Sanitation

### Empowering Women, Transforming Communities: Rani's Tale

In the bustling slums of Patna's China Kothi, Rani Devi, 28, navigates the challenges of supporting her family while striving for a better future. Juggling the roles of a sanitation worker and domestic helper, Rani's meagre earnings barely fulfilled her family's needs. However, a glimmer of hope emerged when she discovered the Women's Mechanized Cleaning Cooperative, a transformative initiative spearheaded by UNFPA and the Patna city authorities.

Transitioning from manual labour to utilizing machines and safety equipment, Rani seizes the opportunity to join, driven by the promise of financial independence and dignity. Through her relentless efforts, she is not only securing economic stability but has also earned the respect of her community.



### Sangeeta's Triumph: A Tale of Toilets and Transformation



Sangeeta Awasthi, a 35 year-old determined woman, found herself thrust into the role of a community leader in the slums of Baba Ghat, Kanpur. Married twenty years ago, she faced the indignity of relieving herself in public due to the lack of proper sanitation facilities in her husband's family. Despite enduring this hardship for years, she reached her breaking point when a non-profit organization, Shramik Bharti, shed light on the importance of sanitation and water rights. Inspired, by this Sangeeta embarked on 'Mission Sanitation', starting from her own home, she scrimped and saved to build a toilet. With the support of government subsidies and Shramik Bharti group, she succeeded. Encouraged by this victory, she turned her attention to the inadequate water supply plaguing her community. Through her determination and leadership, Sangeeta transformed her slum, empowering its residents to live with dignity and basic necessities.



## Women Leaders in Sanitation

### From Classroom to Community: Seema's Swachhata Drive



A teacher at Chandigarh's St Stephan school and a swachhata lover by heart, Mrs. Seema Gupta and her dedication to the cause of swachhata and waste management is truly inspiring. Since 2007, she has been continuously motivating young kids to practice waste segregation, indulge in home composting, and creating waste to art. She has not only raised awareness among students about the importance of sustainable living but also been contributing to a cleaner environment. Mrs. Gupta's dedication to creating a cleaner and greener Chandigarh extends beyond the classroom. She encourages students to check their dustbins before handing over garbage to collectors and consciously avoid plastic products. Her efforts aim not only to educate students but also to inspire their families to adopt good practices together.

### Bhopal's Female Pioneers in Waste Management

Women in Bhopal are taking the lead in maintaining cleanliness and promoting waste segregation initiatives within the city. A collaborative effort between a group of 250 women a brand ambassadors named Sakaratmak Soch and the Bhopal Municipal Corporation ensures that all programs are conducted with zero waste and proper waste disposal practices. Members of this group abstain from events where single-use plastic is present and have implemented utensil banks in 25 wards. Likewise, a Swachhata Kitty Group is actively contributing to the city's cleanliness and spreading awareness about waste segregation. Each member of this group contributes 100 rupees on monthly basis and actively participates in various community activities aimed at enhancing cleanliness and waste management.

### Chandigarh

During the 75th Republic Day celebrations, various cities showcased their innovative tableaux inspired by swachhata. Chandigarh's tableau was crafted entirely out of waste, illustrating the city's transformation into SafaiMitra Surakshit Shehar. Meanwhile, Patna emphasized the importance of embracing Reduce, Reuse, Recycle approach in everyday lives. Several other cities also highlighted the significance and impact of the Swachh Bharat Mission over the past 9 years through their uniquely-themed tableaux.



### Indore

On 2nd February, 2024, Indore hosted an event at Sirpur Lake to celebrate World Wetland Day, showcasing their dedication to environmental conservation. Designed as a zero-waste initiative, the event not only underscored the city's commitment to sustainability but also served as a shining example of their active participation in the Swachh Bharat Mission. At the event, Indore diligently processed 350 Kgs of wet waste and segregated 65 kgs of dry waste on-site, emphasizing the importance of waste reduction and proper disposal methods.

### Bhubaneswar

Bhubaneswar is working hard to provide a safe and conducive environment for its sanitation workers. The city's MC team recently organized a yoga session aimed at nurturing the mental and physical well-being of women SwachhaKarmis, who tirelessly maintain the city's cleanliness. This initiative underscores the city's commitment to not only sanitation but also the holistic health of its workforce.





## Cities in Action

### Chandigarh

Women representatives from Birur, Karnataka, toured Chandigarh to study the waste management strategies employed by the MC. During their visit, the delegates explored various facilities including the Pink MRF, water works and Horticulture Waste plant. Additionally, they received first hand knowledge about the Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) for efficient sewage treatment, as well as the C&D Waste Plant, which manufactures tiles, bricks, and paver blocks.



### Gorakhpur

Gorakhpur's Team Swachh celebrated Swachh Basant program with a special cleanliness campaign at Rani Laxmi Bai Park and municipal gardens. Vibrant flowers and intricate rangoli designs were used for embellishment. Furthermore, the State Govt organized various competitions at the Urban Local Body (ULB) level to promote cleanliness and green initiatives across the region.

### Ratlam

The Swachhata Mini Marathon in Ratlam witnessed enthusiastic participation from individuals of all age groups, each of whom pledged their commitment to cleanliness. A total of 3000 participants actively engaged in the 4-kilometer run dedicated to promoting cleanliness and hygiene.





## Cities in Action

### Dharmshala & Delhi

In a commendable effort towards waste management, Dharamshala has recently set up a Waste to Biogas Plant with a capacity of 5 metric tons per week (MTW) at the IHSDP site. This innovative plant aims to convert organic waste into biogas, contributing to both waste reduction and energy production. Meanwhile, Delhi took a significant step towards its waste management goals by inaugurating a wet waste composting facility in Nizamuddin East, which has a Zero Waste Colony status.



### Suryapet

In a collaborative initiative aimed at fostering self-hygiene and environmental cleanliness, the Suryapet MC team, in partnership with Sant Sewalal Nirankar Sansthan and Tulip internship students, undertook the cleaning of Saddhala Pond in Suryapet, Telangana. This concerted effort to remove harmful plastic waste from the pond signifies a crucial step towards combating water pollution and promoting a healthier environment.

### Ghaziabad

A group of expatriates from fifteen nations visited Sihani Material Recovery Facility in Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam to learn about meticulous waste segregation and circular economy initiatives. The Nagar Nigam team also highlighted free education programs for SafaiMitra's children, promoting sustainable waste management awareness.





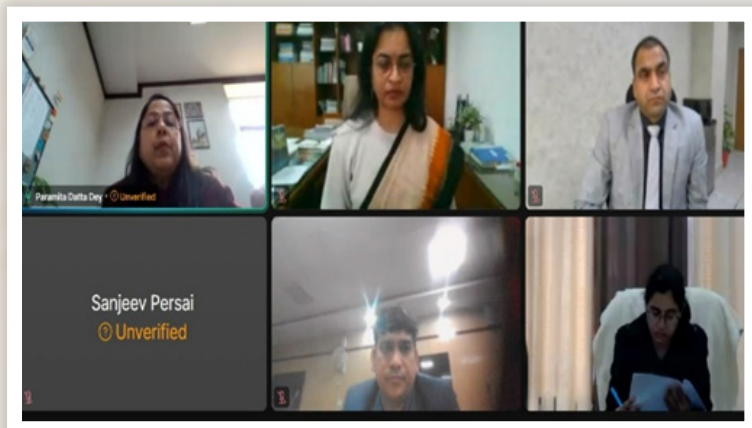
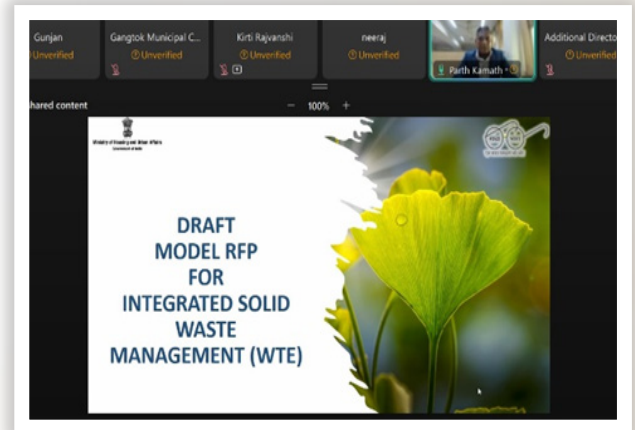


## Capacity Building Initiatives & State Meetings



Team Swachh at the Swachh Survekshan 2024 workshop in Gandhinagar, Gujarat on 30 Jan, 2024, which delved into analyzing Gujarat's performance in SS-2023. The workshop focused on - overview of vital parameters, Swachh certification protocols for ODF, ODF+, ODF++, Water +, and Garbage Free Cities toolkit. The event took place at the Mahatma Mandir convention and exhibition Centre, Gandhinagar. This workshop was specifically tailored for the cities of Gujarat and was attended by key stakeholders including Mayors, Commissioners, Presidents, Chief Officers, and Nodal Officers.

MoHUA prepared model bid documents on Waste to Compost, Material Recovery Facility, Compressed Biogas Projects and Waste-to-Electricity Project. The trainings on these model bid documents organized from 7 to 16 Feb, 2024 aimed to orient State and ULB officials towards the key points of the model bid (RFP and concession agreement documents). These documents are for standardization of the bid processes for development of public private partnership (PPP) projects in waste management sector.



A meeting chaired by Ms. Roopa Mishra, JS & MD, SBMU, MoHUA with State Mission Directors on Swachhata Knowledge Partners (SKPs). 23 SKPs have been empaneled under SBM-U 2.0, in order to provide comprehensive capacity development support to States and cities to accelerate the implementation and achieve outcomes.

## Capacity Building Initiatives & State Meetings



To bolster technical collaboration in the field of mechanical engineering under SBM-U, Dr V K Chaurasia Joint Adviser from CPHEEO, visited CMERI, Durgapur on the occasion of its 67th Foundation Day celebration on 26 Feb, 2024. SBM-U is in discussions with CMERI for support in testing of equipment and machines under Swachh Bharat, developing SOP, guidelines for training relevant personnel in waste management sector and training.

A meeting to review the status of progress of flagship Missions of SBM 2.0 & AMRUT 2.0 on utilization of UIDF for supplementary funding to achieve water secure and garbage free cities convened on 14 February, 2024.
